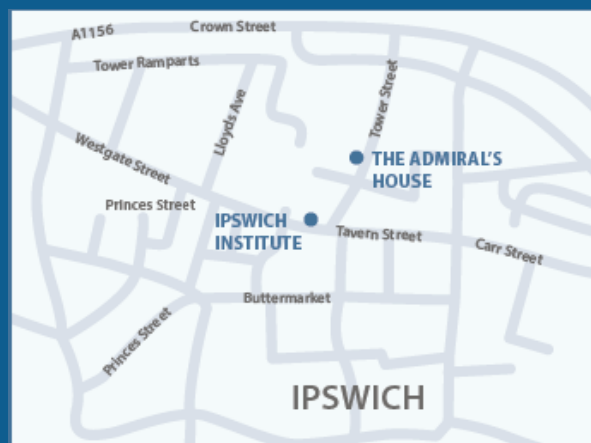
Spanish for Complete Beginners

TUESDAY

Creative Sketchbooking

This course is designed for both newcomers and regulars who wish to further develop their artwork. Sketchbook practice is a central tool for creative thinking and recording observations. A wide variety of drawing and painting techniques will be explored along with input on key aspects of design, layout and idea generation. The theme or approach this term will be 'Counterpoint' with a focus on mixed-media techniques, and with optional tasks to help students develop personal interests, ideas and themes.

This course will explore a range of textile techniques including feltmaking, appliqué, dyeing and printmaking. You will be guided through a series of practical sessions and will have the opportunity to develop your own ideas and projects. There will be some stitching involved, but the emphasis is on experimenting with a range of textile materials. Suitable for beginners and those wanting to explore textiles further. *There will be a small charge for materials and you will be advised at the first session of the basic equipment needed.*

These will be followed by a discussion on the week's topic, guided by the tutor. The first session will also cover research and presentation techniques.

Aspects of 20th Century Art

From the late 19th century pre-Raphaelites to the present day. The aim will be to observe how art during this 'modern era' led to a break from the past and continuity with it. Artists such as Lowry, Munch, Nash and Henri (of the American Ash Can School) will illustrate this change and acceptance of past art history. Slides and texts will be used for both class discussions and comment by tutor and learners. No prior knowledge will be needed just an interest in art history.
